CHILDREN'S HABILITATION RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM WAIVER (CHRP)



What is it?

The Children's Habilitation Residential Program (CHRP) Waiver provides support for children and young adults (birth through age 20), who have an intellectual or developmental disability, very high needs or a serious emotional disturbance. This program is specifically for children and young adults who are in need of or at risk of out-of-home placement.

Age
Under 21 years old



Determination
Determined to have a Developmental Disability or Delay (if under 5)



Financial
Long-Term Care Medicaid Criteria
Meets Social Security Disability definition and financial requirements for Health First Colorado Medicaid



Daily Living
Needs support with some or all activities of daily living
